History

The Aston Harald Group is a family owned organisation with operations in a number of industries. The family started in the industrial marine business and over the course of 15 years, expanded the organisation from one with an international footprint to a true multi-national with a presence on every continent. Such coverage allowed them to be close to all of their customers offering fast support and service wherever they were, an attribute very well received in the marine industry and something the organisation became well known and appreciated for.

In 2013 they decided to sell the business after 15 successful years and start something new. Their main focus has always been the development and expansion of companies not just *for* their customers but *with* them, creating bilateral values and benefits. With this ethos in mind, they set up Aston Harald Composite on the island of Hönö in the North Gothenburg archipelago and built a state of the art production facility for composite components. Large investments were made in a highly skilled workforce, state-of-the-art facilities and equipment and a goal was set:

Build a company renowned for high quality products, build a brand recognised for innovation, craftsmanship and passion. And last but not least, continue the family trait of commitment to good customer service.

Additional investments have been made in various parallel operations that complement the organisation and add value for the group as a whole as well as its' customers, a true testament to the vision and commitment of the owners.

The journey that ended in 2013 was the start of a new one which has now gathered momentum and we are all looking forward to where it takes us and the challenges that lie ahead.

The Beginning

This second journey began at pace when Aston Harald AB acquired the design & production rights of the high performance carbon fibre racing catamaran - the M32. The brand new facility, Aston Harald Composite began building M32s and a production system was built up around the boat. We have since applied this quality system to other areas of composite applications and the company has evolved into the multifaceted facility it now is, meaning that today our customers come from a broad range of industries where often the only common factor is a need of high quality, precision crafted composite parts.

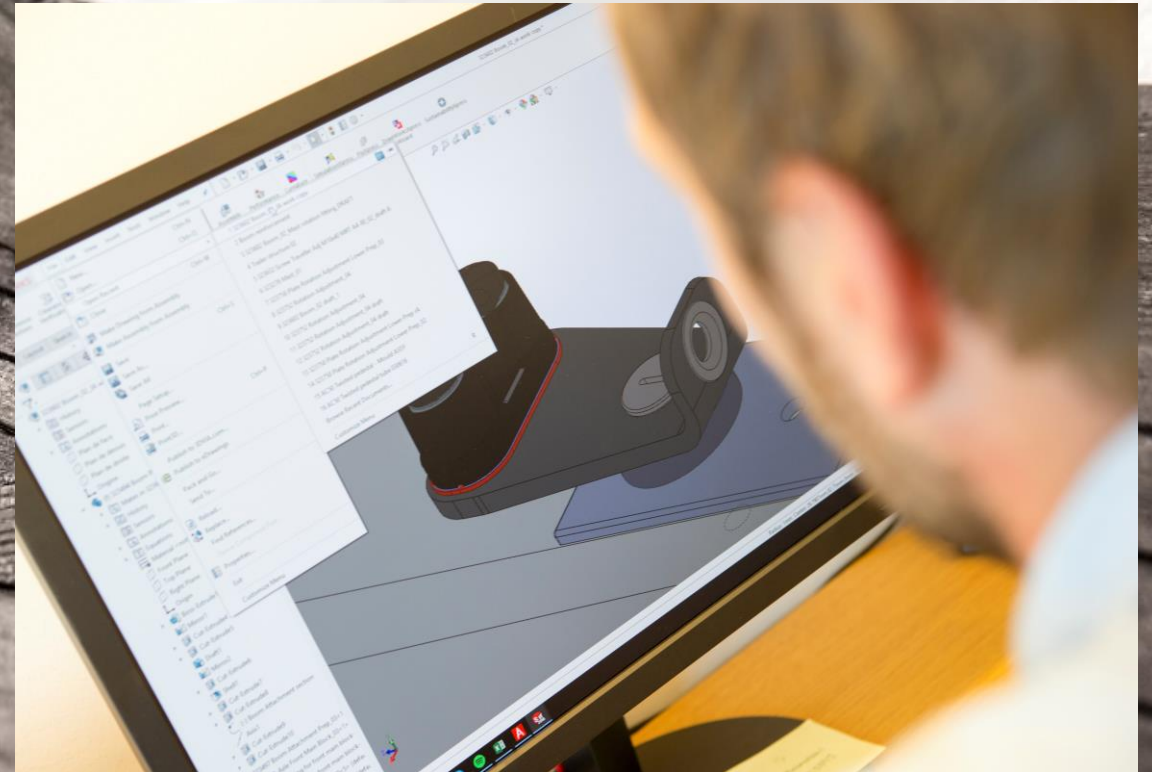
Our production is focused on 4 main areas of composite application:

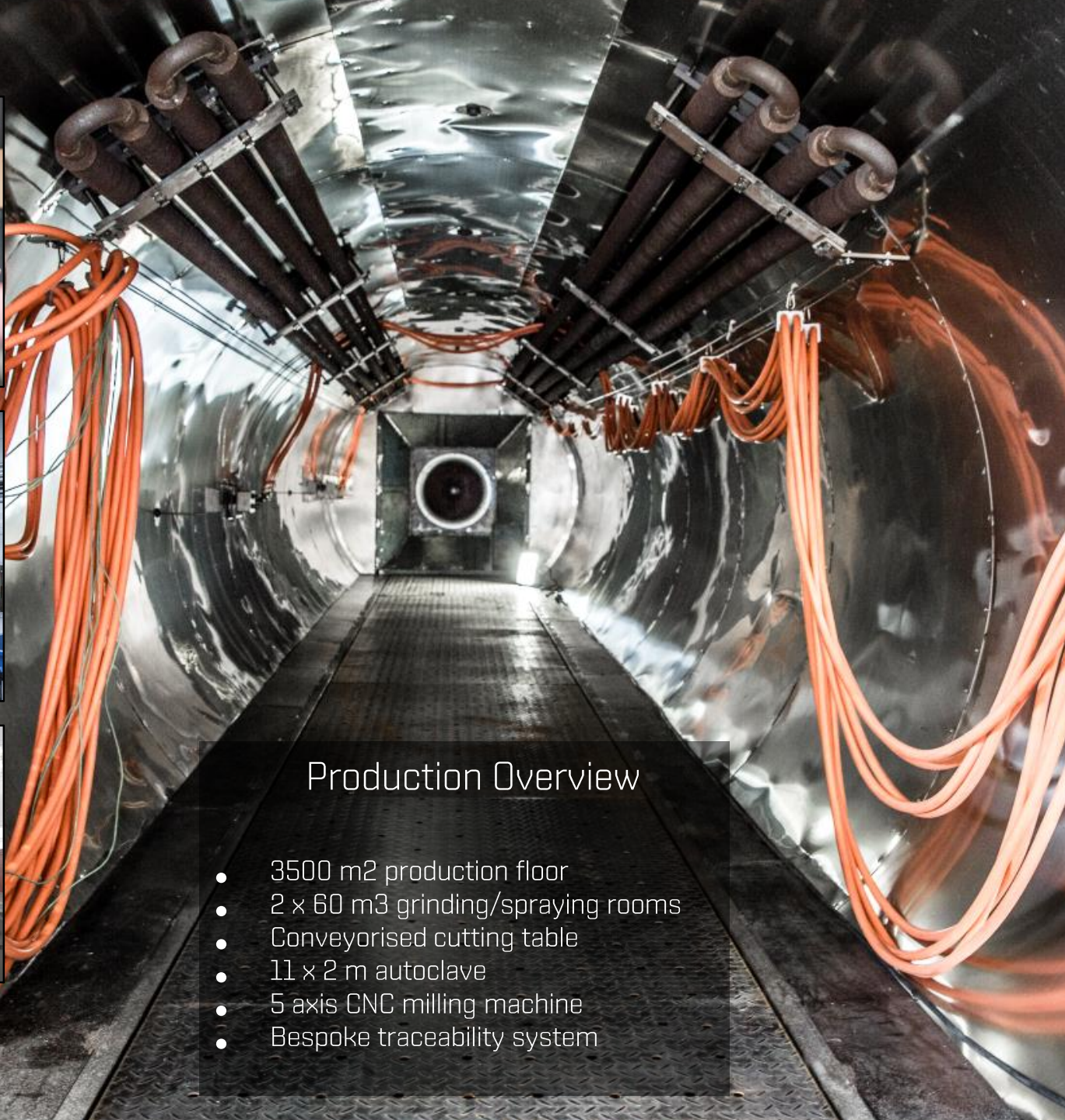
- Automotive

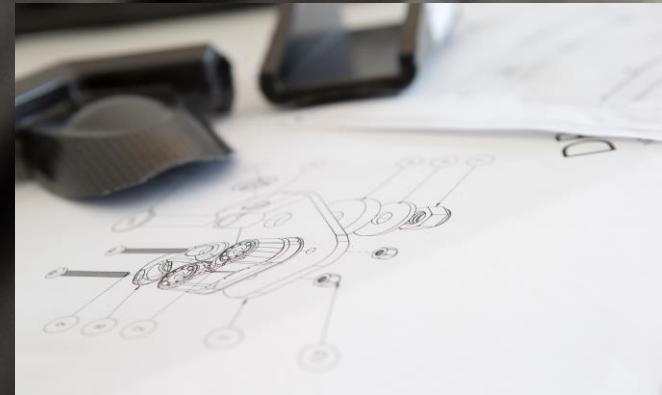


Production Overview

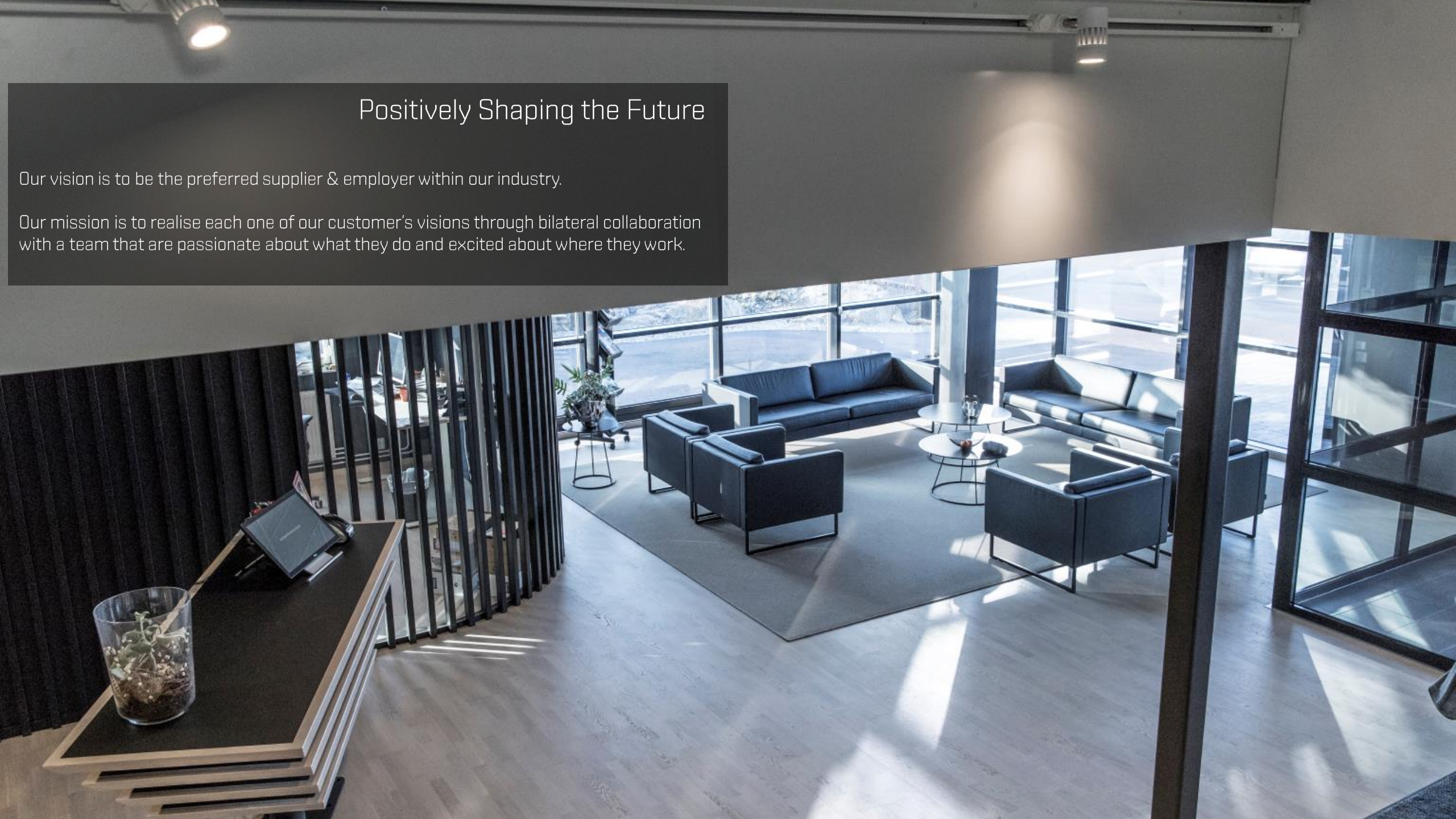
Advancement Through Research
